- Two accompanying adults are present from beginning to end to support the workshop leader and to supervise the children during the final 45 minutes of the program.
- Mühlerama provides sirup, water, plates, cutlery, drinking cups and napkins.
- The workshop leader is responsible for the safety of the children. If the workshop leader sees a child or the orderly operation of the museum jeopardized, he or she is obligated to act accordingly.
- Insurance is the responsibility of the participants.
- For the use of other offers of the museum after the birthday program an admission fee is required.
- A fee of 120.– is charged for cancellations, which are requested fewer than 3 days before the reserved date. Sickness is an exception.

Baking Bread

Spend an exciting afternoon with your birthday boy or girl and his or her friends baking bread and sliding down the sack slide! From flour, salt, water and yeast, each child makes his or her own dough. How much strength and endurance it takes to knead the sticky mass into a smooth dough! While the dough rests under the bowl, the children learn how the mill works. Then it's up to the top floor, where the sack slide awaits. Like a full flour sack, we hurtle down the fast-paced curves!

Back in the bakery, the task is to transform the dough into small works of art: Can it be a prickly hedgehog, a cat or even a snarling crocodile? As soon as the imaginative creations are baking in the oven and emitting their delicious aroma, it's time to celebrate the birthday!

The first two hours the children are supervised by the workshop leader. During this time you can prepare the snack and decorate the table. Plates, cutlery, drinking cups and napkins are provided. In the last 45 minutes you will celebrate the birthday. During that time you take responsibility for the children.

Baking Cupcakes

Spend an exciting afternoon with your birthday child and their friends baking cupcakes and sliding down the sack slide! The children make cupcakes for the following birthday party. A yummy dough is made from a variety of ingredients. While the cupcakes are being baked in the oven, the children learn how the mill works. Then it's up to the top floor, where the sack slide awaits. Like a full flour sack, we hurtle down the fast-paced curves!

Back in the bakery, the buttercream is prepared. Finally, the fragrant cupcakes are decorated with devotion. Each child makes four cupcakes. So that there is just enough to take home two or three more.

For the first two hours, the workshop leader supervises the children. During that time you can set up the birthday table. In the final 45 minutes, the birthday party takes place in the bakery. Then you take over the responsibility for the children. Plates, cutlery, drinking cups and napkins are provided. A cake is not necessary because the children can enjoy their own artistic creations. Enjoy the cupcakes!

The “Ghost School” is a carefully designed, age-appropriate program. It is playful, interesting and a little cheeky and spooky. At Mühlerama, we do not satisfy the need for wild and loud celebrations.

- This activity can also be booked outside the museum’s opening hours.
- Program and birthday party last for 2 hours overall.
- For security measures, the maximum number of participating children is 12.
- The children have to be 5 years old. Exception: younger siblings of the birthday child.
- Two accompanying adults are present from beginning to end.
- The birthday party takes place in the cosy and dim “Ghost School” itself.
We recommend to let this special atmosphere speak for itself and to do without party decorations.
- For fire safety reasons, candles, table crackers etc. are not allowed. (When the weather is nice in summer, the birthday party can also take place outside in the courtyard. Candles etc. are no problem there.)
- For hygienic reasons, cakes with glaze, patisserie or snacks, smarties and chips are not allowed. Sandwiches, bread and cake without glaze are allowed
- Mühlerama provides sirup, water, plates, cutlery, drinking cups and napkins.

With Spixi as our guide, we learn what a real ghost can do and transform into little ghosts. Then we quietly and secretly float through the mill. Woo, boo, hoo, what will we encounter on our trip? It gets really spooky when Spixi shows us its bed chamber in the dark and scary attic.

When this test of courage is passed, all ghosts slide down the sack slide. In the last half hour, the birthday party takes place in the spook hideout.

The program is conducted by a workshop leader. They are supported by the two accompanying adults of the birthday groups. While the group is haunting the mill, one accompanying adult can prepare the spook hideout for the celebration. During the last half hour, the accompanying adults are responsible for the children.



- This activity can also be booked outside the museum’s opening hours.
- Program and birthday party last for 2 hours overall.
- For security measures, the maximum number of participating children is 12.
- The children have to be 5 years old. Exception: younger siblings of the birthday child.
- Two accompanying adults are present from beginning to end.
- The birthday party takes place in the cosy and dim mice nest itself. We recommend to let this special atmosphere speak for itself and to do without party decorations.
